What does the course cover and how is it assessed?

Unit IA: Managing health and safety

Unit IB: Hazardous substances/agents

Unit IC: Workplace and work equipment safety

Unit DNI: Application of health and safety management in the workplace. Units IA, IB and IC are each assessed by a written examination. Unit DNI is a workplace-based assignment, requiring students to conduct a review of health and safety arrangements in their own organisation. It is a common practical unit that can contribute to achievement of the NEBOSH National Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety.
